Practice Round February 1st – Mid-High 70's 2018 WEATHER:

Round 1 February 2nd – Perfect High 70's
Round 2 February 3rd – High 60's Low 70's, Windy and Overcast

Round 3 February 4th – High 70's Perfect

2018 COURSE USAGE: Practice Round – We had A LOT of action after the 12:30 cut off. 65 Players from 12:30-1:30 Matt and Luke assigned each group going out to play golf a que time off of 1 or 10 and this worked out great! Continue this process in the upcoming years!

Friday – Same process as Thursday. We had A LOT of Action of members trying to play golf. Matt was the starter and again put them in a que to tee off of hole 1 only. 40 golfers all at 1PM trying to tee off. 1 member complained about this process, however this is the smartest and most reliable way to get everyone on the golf course. Continue this for upcoming years!

Saturday – This was the worst of all the days leading up. We had almost 70 players try and tee off the 1st hole right at 1PM. We had 4 matches go extra holes. Matt again was the starter and assigned people a que time to tee off 1. We had many comments and nasty remarks about this process, however this is the only logical way of doing it unless we advertise TEE Times to the membership a month before, 3 weeks before, 2 weeks before and leading up to the event. We initially had people leave because of this process. Entire golf staff had an issue with someone either in the event or not give them a nasty remark. With this amount of golf in the afternoon, the attention from the entire golf staff turned to trying to accommodate 70 players to get out on hole 1 instead of focusing on play for the Sarazen.

Sunday – This was the least amount of play of the weekend. We held back Brandon from joining the shootout and worked with Dan to start play off of hole #1 and #10. Only about 10 Groups or less tried to tee off right at 1:00. We held them until 1:15 to allow Max and Brian to jump ahead and cool off the greens. Sunday at 1:00 greens were stimped at 12.10 and Nick wanted them to be cooled off.

REGISTRATION:

Entries are e-mailed to proshop@holeinthewallgolf.org beginning at 9:00AM on November 15th. We need to make sure this is very clear to the membership leading up to this date. We need to be sure we are doing everything correct. Last year we didn't have enough sign ups. THIS YEAR WE HAD EMAILS SENT TO THE JUNK FILE. WE NEED TO CHECK THIS JUNK BOX TO MAKE SURE WE HAVE ALL ENTRIES.

COMMUNICATION & TIMELINE: 11/8: Luke posted three signs in the locker room letting men know of the sign up procedure

11/13: Email was sent through Golf Genius to the Holers for Wednesday game as well as a reminder of the sign up for Sarazan Cup

11/14: Email was sent from our broadcast system letting members know the correct email and when to send for the email

11/14-11/20: Emails were sent to those currently in the field and those on the waitlist.

11/20: Brandon ordered the Prizes for the event

11/29: Aaron sent out through golf genius an email to the 40 signed up at the time to get guest information.

12/14: Aaron sent out individual emails to those who have not given us back Guest Information

12/22: Aaron sent out the Link for the Peter Millar Favors to 77 players through Golf Genius.

We are still waiting on a few more emails and guest information from some

12/23: Aaron reached out through proshop email regarding missing guest information

1/3: Aaron sent out another email to the field so they can select their Peter Millar Favors!

1/10: Luke and Brandon called out to the remaining 12 players who have not selected favors! As of 3:30 on the 10th we had 71 players who have selected items.

1/12: Email to 6 Participants mentioning today is the Final Deadline to select Favor! (1/18 is the actual deadline, however we wanted to have them selected before in case of any changes)

1/31: Luke sent out the First Round Tee Times to the entire field with a description of the weekend and rules of the event

2/2: Luke sent out round 2 tee times at 5:20 after the first day.

2/2: Brandon charged the event participants \$700

2/3: Sent out final round shotgun time notice to the entire field.

2/4: Sent out the final results and a thank you for participation email to the entire field.

FIELD: 80 Players (40 Members and 40 Guests) **COCKTAIL PARTY:** 60 PARTICIPANTS

FORMAT: Four-Ball match play within flights using 80% of course handicap on the January 15th revision. Matches will be stroked off the low player in the group with a maximum of 10 strokes between partners and 18 strokes given.

Teams losing their first match will go into a consolation flight. There will be a medal play (Dunlap Flight) competition on Sunday for teams eliminated on Saturday.

Overall Champion will be determined by the shootout of the five flight winners. Shootout will be sudden death alternate shot of the partners played at scratch from flight appropriate tees on the 18th hole. Prizes will be awarded to flight winners and consolation flight winners.

Tie Break Procedure

If there is a tie after 18 Holes on Friday or Saturday, the match will continue to Hole #1 in a sudden death format, until a winner is decided. Strokes will continue as noted on the scorecard.

Should there be a tie on Sunday for the Flight Winner, both teams will enter into the shootout, the team that lasts the longest in the shootout will be the flight winner. If both tied teams remain tied at the completion of the shootout, they will proceed to Hole #9 and play an alternate shot until a winner of the flight is decided.

If there is a tie in the Consolation Final – those two teams will proceed to Hole #9 and play alternate shot until a winner is decided.

Matches: Friday - With the change to No ½ Up rule. Only <u>1 Team</u> went extra holes on Day 1 Saturday - We had <u>4 matches</u> go extra holes with 70 non participants try and get out to play regular golf.

Sunday- No matches went to extra holes based on the Sunday Match Rules. Most play finished in about 4 Hours and 15 Minutes. A few of the Dunlap flights finished in 4 hours and 30 Minutes

Shoot Out: We had 5 flights Compete for the overall champion. Matt set up the tee locations on hole 18 before the event. In the past, when they have gone an extra hole, we had a par three set up on 18. Matt was prepared for this, however the shootout finished on the first hole.

9th Hole Shoot: With the possibility with the new Match Play rules that the Committee had voted on, there was a chance to have as many as 14 groups on hole nine to determine the Flight Winner or Flight Consolation Winner. We were fortunate enough that not a single match had to go extra holes, or in this case to the 9th hole for a playoff.

Dunlap Flight: Only had 1 group not show due to battling an injury. We were able to get Jim Healey to bring a guest as a fill in and just play golf. We had 1 group come in about 4 Hours, not sure if they played all the holes or just played real fast. Rest of the field came in about 4:30. Reusche and Murray won with a Net 63.

PAIRINGS: Pairings were made by Luke and also by Handicap for the Matches. The Dunlap flight was paired by personality and pace of play.

HANDICAP %: 80% of course handicap on the January 15th revision. Matches will be stroked off the low player in the group with a maximum of 10 strokes between partners and 18 strokes given.

HANDICAPS: Aaron had every handicap ready after January 15th. He double checked and triple checked and Luke and Jon confirmed a few days before the event.

COURSE SETUP: Nick and his staff did normal set up for the event. Matt set the hole locations for all three days and checked them in the mornings, also coordinated with Jon and Nick about setting different tee boxes.

SCOREBOARDS: See Photos Below* Alex created the scoreboards in House. Last couple of years we created the scoreboards at Kinkos

SCORECARDS: Luke created all scorecards for the event and had Aaron and JB double check them. (Located in the P Drive)

TEE TIMES: Luke was in charge of the Golf Genius and created the tee times. They flipped each day. If they teed off first on Friday they teed off last on Saturday. (Located in the P Drive)

STARTING: Jon did all Sarazen Cup Starting and announced them to the Tee. *Suggestion for upcoming years to advertise if you are not on the tee 5 minutes before your starting time a penalty will be enforced.* We had multiple participants show up at the last second for their tee time which slowed down pace of play.

PACE OF PLAY: Friday – Pace was fine, no major issues. A few groups fell back but the professional staff did a great job keeping the groups moving.

Saturday – Pace of play was fine, no major issues. Most play was about 4.15 and 4.30. Matches finished by 16 or 17 or went extra holes. Hard to keep an eye on the matches later in the day due to the amount of afternoon golfers.

Sunday- 4:00 were the first groups. 4:30 was the rest of the field.

SCORING: Alex was stationed at the scoreboard at all times and doing calligraphy for the winners.

OTHER NOTES:

- -Next Year Highly consider sending an email out to the general membership a week in advance letting them know about the upcoming week. Also consider actually having starting TEE TIMES Thursday through Sunday. Call in to book your tee time after 1:00PM. This may help with less traffic and confusion on the first tee
- A few comments regarding 18 Hole Matches and not 9 Hole Match Play 2/2 JB
- A few complaints regarding which tee's they were supposed to play (but falls based on Handicap) 2/2
- Multiple people asked if consolation bracket were able to make it back into the shootout.
- Many players came to the 1st tee right at their tee time or a few minutes after. In Next year's emails and pamphlets suggest making a note to say please be on the 1st tee 5 Minutes before your starting time (suggest a penalty if they aren't)
- Communication and staff did an excellent job being where they needed to be and communicating the right things.
- Possibly look into having at least <u>4 or 5 more radios</u> on hand for the staff. We were short on radios and had to divert to text messaging.
- Cool thought would be to have a live scoreboard at the turn? Have a TV of each match on Friday and Saturday on Hole 10 to see how everyone is playing.
- Ranger Thought?: If staff amount works out on Friday and Saturday We could assign 1 Ranger/Rules Official for every 4 or 5 matches that tee off. They would stay with that group the entire round. Example: Squire Flight Followed by Aaron Knight Flight Followed by Luke Slammer Flight Followed by Brandon King Flight followed by Matt Bear Flight Followed by Blake (or outside staff). Then once Jon is finished with starting can float throughout the entire field as an additional ranger/rules official.


